Phonics	This week's focus: reading words with the consonant digraphs - ck, qu, ch, sh  • Lesson 1 blending ck  • Lesson 2 blending qu  • Lesson 3 blending ch  • Lesson 4 blending sh  Practise daily the High Frequency Words Grids added to Seesaw to help quicker recognition when read whole words. Start with set 1 and only move to set2-3 when your child can read each whole word confidently, without any sounding out.				
Literacy	For the next two week we will be using the story 'The Odd Egg by Emily Gravett', as our focus text. Links to each session will be available via <b>Seesaw</b> or the download area. It is Year 1 unit but will be adapted for Rec. Activities will be available via <b>Seesaw</b> .  Session 1— What do you know about eggs? Find out which animals lay egg.  Session 2— Listen to part of the story (start from 5mins)- talk about how Duck might be feeling. What might he be saying?  Session 3— Write simple sentence about how Duck feels in the story.  Daily letter formation— activities available in the download area.				

Maths	Building 9, 10 – week 1 This week is all about different ways to represent 9 and 10, counting to 9 and 10 and using a 10 frame. Collect objects from around the house or garden eg. spoons, nuts and bolts, keys, pasta shapes, buttons, paper clips, sticks, dice, lego blocks  Click on the link to access the daily videos and view the activities – or access via Seesaw each day.  Listen: stories linked on Seesaw - Ten Black Dots – Donald Crews, How do Dinosaurs Count to 10? - Yolen & Teague, One Gorilla – Atsuko Morozumi,  Songs – counting: Counting to 10, 10 little numbers, subitising: Subitise Rock, Subitizing: Number fluency (say what you see, without counting)  Number formation - Sheets will be available to download via the link on your weekly email.
