<b>Warm-up</b>	These will be available <b>daily</b> on <b>Seesaw</b> and will include the calendar, letter or number formation. <b>Alphablocks</b> – <a href="#">spelling tricky words</a> , <a href="#">Baby animals</a>
<b>Zoom</b>	Please join via the <b>link</b> sent as an <b>attachment</b> on the previous <b>email</b> . <b>Monday / *Friday</b> 9:30 Whole class with Mrs Quick <b>Wednesday</b> – 9:30 Phonics with Mrs Holt 10:15 Phonics with Mrs Quick <b>*Friday</b> – ‘Show and tell’ Do you have a hobby or interest that you could talk about to the class? If you want to tell us about something, think about what you want to say and show.
<b>Phonics</b>	<b>This week’s focus: reading words with the consonant digraphs - ck, qu, ch, sh</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lesson 1 <a href="#">blending ck</a></li> <li>Lesson 2 <a href="#">blending qu</a></li> <li>Lesson 3 <a href="#">blending ch</a></li> <li>Lesson 4 <a href="#">blending sh</a></li> </ul> Practise <b>daily</b> the <b>High Frequency Words Grids</b> added to <b>Seesaw</b> to help quicker recognition when read whole words. Start with set 1 and only move to set2-3 when your child can read each whole word confidently, without any sounding out.
<b>Literacy</b>	For the next two week we will be using the story ‘The Odd Egg by Emily Gravett’, as our focus text. Links to each session will be available via <b>Seesaw</b> or the download area. It is Year 1 unit but will be adapted for Rec. Activities will be available via <b>Seesaw</b> . <b>Session 1</b> – What do you know about eggs? Find out which animals lay egg. <b>Session 2</b> – Listen to part of the story (start from 5mins)- talk about how Duck might be feeling. What might he be saying? <b>Session 3</b> – Write simple sentence about how Duck feels in the story. <b>Daily letter formation</b> – activities available in the <b>download area</b> .

Maths	<p><b>Building 9, 10 – week 1</b> This week is all about different ways to represent 9 and 10, counting to 9 and 10 and using a 10 frame. Collect objects from around the house or garden eg. spoons, nuts and bolts, keys, pasta shapes, buttons, paper clips, sticks, dice, lego blocks</p> <p>Click on the link to access the <a href="#">daily videos</a> and view the activities – or access via <b>Seesaw</b> each day.</p> <p><b>Listen:</b> stories linked on <b>Seesaw</b> - Ten Black Dots – Donald Crews, How do Dinosaurs Count to 10? - Yolen &amp; Teague, One Gorilla – Atsuko Morozumi,</p> <p><b>Songs</b> – counting: <a href="#">Counting to 10</a>, <a href="#">10 little numbers</a>, subitising: <a href="#">Subitise Rock</a>, <a href="#">Subitizing: Number fluency</a> (say what you see, without counting)</p> <p><b>Number formation</b> - Sheets will be available to download via the link on your weekly email.</p>
Reading (aloud)	<p><b>Please ensure your child has chance to hear a story being read every day.</b></p> <p>Alternatively let them listen to one on the <a href="#">Sharing Children's Stories</a> site.</p> <p>Use the <a href="#">Oxford Owl</a> website to select <b>pink level</b> books for your child to read.</p> <p>Listen to other Traditional tales on BBC school Radio – <a href="#">EYFS: Listen and Play</a></p>

Which animals lay eggs?</p> <p><b>Technology – online safety</b></p> <p>Listen to the story: <a href="#">Chicken Clicking</a></p> <p>- issues to discuss password safety, posting personal information, taking/sharing photos, meeting online friends, reliability</p>
