Dear Parents

Firstly, thank you to all of you for your support and understanding with wearing a face covering when on the playground and also social distancing as much as possible. As you may recall we forwarded a letter from Dean Wallace Director of Public Health for Derbyshire:

'I'd also ask you to consider wearing a face covering when dropping off and collecting your children as an additional measure to help reduce the risk of Covid-19 spreading. This doesn't replace social distancing but is an extra recommendation to reduce the potential risk of transmission.'

Staff on the gate will now be wearing a face covering at either end of the day. We really appreciate your help as some of our staff are clinically vulnerable, or live with people who are.
