Mrs Quick will be adding daily videos on Seesaw, so you can listen and follow the story.</p>
PE	<p>Choose from...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Join Joe Wicks – live on Wednesday and Friday mornings. Choose a Cosmic Kids Yoga video to follow. Practise your dance moves with Jump Start Jonny. <p>In school we will be doing the daily 1000 step challenge including Mrs Quick – running/walking around the playgrounds (weather permitting)!</p>
Topic	<p>Science: video and activities will be available via Seesaw or via the download link</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we will be looking at common UK mammals – identifying them and looking at similarities and differences.
	<p>History: Video and activities will be available via Seesaw or via the download link</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduction to our new topic for this half term – Castles and Dragons. Finding out who built the first castles in the UK and why.
