In school the children will be sharing some of their favourite books in quiz</p>
Phonics	<p>Daily videos are available via Letter and Sounds</p> <p>This week's focus: reading words with the vowel digraphs ai, ee, igh,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lesson 1: blending ai listen: Snail and the Whale • Lesson 2: blending ee • Lesson 3: blending igh • Lesson 4: review <p>Practise daily the High Frequency Words Grids added to Seesaw, to help quicker recognition when read whole words. Only move to the next set when your child can read each whole word confidently, without any sounding out.</p>
Literacy	<p>We will be continuing with the story 'The Odd Egg by Emily Gravett', as our focus text. Links to each session will be available via Seesaw or the download area. It is Year 1 unit but will be adapted for Rec. Watch the daily videos via the Seesaw link.</p> <p>Session 4 – adding labels to describe eggs eg. big egg, spotty egg</p> <p>Session 5 – Making a certificate for a winning egg.</p> <p>Session 6 – Writing simple sentences.</p> <p>Reading: Additional Funky Phonic reader will be available in the download area.</p> <p>Daily letter formation: activities available in the download area.</p>
